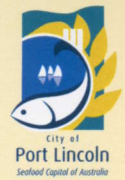
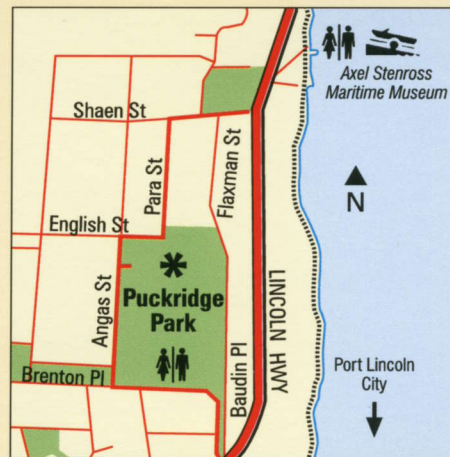
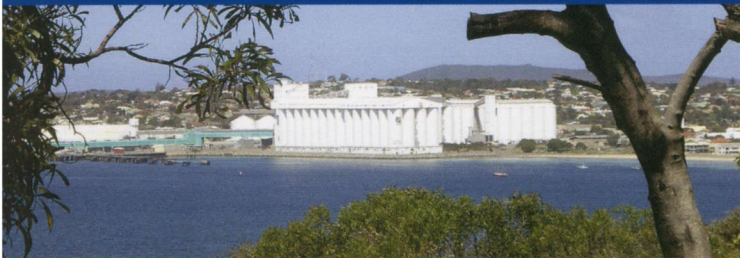
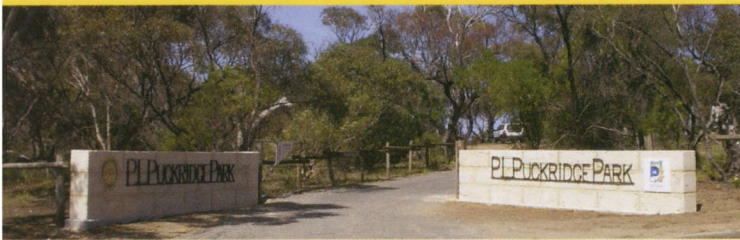


Puckridge Park
